Admission procedure for the Master's degree programme
with assessment of entry requirements and personal knowledge in:

Architettura (Restauro) **Architecture (Conservation)**

Faculty of Architecture

Degree Class: LM-4; code to be entered on Infostud: **33430**

1. Stages of the procedure

To be admitted to the programme, you must:

- a. **Pay** the fee of €10.00 in accordance with the procedures and deadlines set out in point 3.
- b. **Wait for the outcome** of the eligibility check. **If you do not meet the entry requirements**, you may acquire the missing credits by passing single examinations.
The procedures and costs are set out in the section 'Single Examinations' of the Regulations for Attendance at Bachelor's and Master's Degree Programmes and for Student Fees

- c. **Carry out the personal skills assessment** in accordance with the procedures set out in point 4.
- d. **Proceed with enrolment** by paying the course enrolment fees in accordance with the procedures and deadlines set out in point 5.
Enrolment can only take place once the Student Affairs Office has sent an email confirming the successful outcome of the eligibility and personal knowledge checks.

For students coming from other Italian universities

Students coming from other Italian universities must follow the instructions set out in point 4, 'Verification of personal qualifications', in the subsection 'For students who have obtained or are about to obtain their degree from other Italian universities'.

Before submitting your application, you must check that you have uploaded your identity document to Infostud, under 'Profile > Personal documents'.

For students who have not yet obtained their degree

Where the course regulations so provide, students who have not yet obtained their degree (at Sapienza or at other universities) may also apply for verification of their eligibility, subject to the requirement to obtain it by 23 January 2027 (for students who have not yet obtained their

degree at Sapienza) and by 19 December 2026 (for students who have not yet obtained their degree from other Italian or international universities).

For students from abroad and/or holding a qualification obtained within a foreign education system

The procedures for students from abroad are set out in point 6.

2. Admission requirements

To be admitted to the Master's degree programme, applicants must:

- hold a bachelor's degree in class L-17, L-23 or L-7 under Ministerial Decree 270/04 (or in class 4 or 8 under Ministerial Decree 509/1999), or another qualification obtained abroad that has been recognised as equivalent;
- have passed the compulsory admission tests for enrolment on a bachelor's degree programme and/or a single-cycle master's degree programme leading to the qualification of architect, as regulated annually at national level by the Ministry;
- hold certified or self-certified proof of proficiency in English equivalent to level B2;
- have 108 CFU in the scientific disciplinary sectors (SSD) specified as follows:
 - Computer science, information processing and mathematics, totalling 8 CFU to be chosen from: INF/01 - ING-INF/05 - MAT/02 - MAT/03 - MAT/05 - MAT/06 - MAT/07 - MAT/08 - MAT/09;
 - Physical, technical and building services disciplines for architecture, totalling 8 CFU to be chosen from: FIS/01 - ING-IND/10 - ING-IND/11;
 - Historical subjects for architecture, totalling 16 CFU in ICAR/18;
 - Representation subjects, totalling 12 CFU to be chosen from: ICAR/06 - ICAR/17;
 - Architectural and urban design subjects, totalling 20 CFU in ICAR/14;
 - Subjects in architectural, interior and landscape design, totalling 4 CFU to be chosen from: ICAR/14 - ICAR/15 - ICAR/16;
 - Subjects in architectural restoration, totalling 4 CFU in ICAR/19;
 - Structural subjects, totalling 8 CFU to be chosen from: ICAR/07 – ICAR/08 – ICAR/09;
 - Urban design and spatial planning subjects, totalling 12 CFU to be chosen from: ICAR/20 – ICAR/21;
 - Courses in technological architectural design, totalling 12 CFU to be chosen from: ICAR/10 – ICAR/11 – ICAR/12;
 - Courses in cost estimation for architecture and urban planning, totalling 4 CFU in ICAR/22.

Any additional course credits required must be obtained prior to the assessment of personal knowledge.

3. Verification of eligibility

Eligibility checks must be requested by paying a €10.00 fee from 2 July 2026 and by one of the following dates, as chosen:

- 15 September 2026 (the only applicable date for applicants from non-EU countries requiring a student visa)
- 15 October 2026
- 17 November 2026
- 17 December 2026
- 14 January 2027 (date reserved for students who have already graduated from Sapienza or are about to graduate).

The payment is generated via the Infostud system.

The **payment** is made online via PagoPA (direct payment).

The **code** to be entered into the system is **33430**.

The **result** of the eligibility check will be sent to your institutional email account (if active) or to the personal email address provided on Infostud.

4. Assessment of personal knowledge

In addition to verifying that candidates meet the specific academic requirements, the Selection Committee assesses the suitability of candidates' personal background by analysing their CV and the content of the courses they have undertaken, evaluating their overall alignment with the knowledge required for admission.

For students who obtained their degree from Sapienza

After paying the €10 fee for the eligibility check (code **33430**) you must:

- download and complete the **self-certification form** for the degree obtained (XLS file [verifica requisiti di accesso CdLMAR](#))
- download and complete the **self-certification form for B2-level English language proficiency** ([en autocertificazione](#))

and send all documents by email to architetturaar@uniroma1.it stating "Candidatura CdLM AR 2026/2027 – Candidate's Surname" in the subject line"

For students who have obtained or are about to obtain their degree from other Italian universities

After paying the €10 payment slip for the eligibility requirements check (code **33430**) you must:

- download and complete the **self-certification form** for the degree obtained (XLS file [verifica requisiti di accesso CdLMAR](#))
- download and complete the **self-certification form for B2-level English language proficiency** ([en autocertificazione](#))

- download and complete the form entitled "**Dichiarazione laurea ed esami per verifica requisiti**", available on the University website on the student forms page <https://www.uniroma1.it/en/pagina/student-forms> indicating the examinations taken and the Scientific and Disciplinary Sectors corresponding to the courses
- attach the syllabuses for each exam taken, in PDF format, specifying the CFU and SSD and send all documents by email to architetturaar@uniroma1.it stating in the subject line "Application for CdLM AR 2026/2027 – Candidate's Surname"

Documents for the assessment of prior knowledge must be submitted by the same date chosen for payment of the eligibility assessment fee (one of the five dates indicated in point 3: 15 September, 15 October, 17 November, 17 December 2026 or 14 January 2027)

5. Enrolment

Enrolment is granted upon payment of the course enrolment fees, following the successful completion of the assessment of entry requirements and personal knowledge.

The **payment slip** is generated via the Infostud system.

Payment is made online via PagoPA (direct payment).

The **code** to be entered into the system is **33430**.

6. For students who hold a qualification from a foreign education system

The procedures vary depending on citizenship and country of residence.

For citizens of non-EU countries who reside abroad and are applying for a student visa, and for students from China participating in the Marco Polo programme who have chosen the English-language programme

In these cases, you must hold a mandatory letter of pre-acceptance.

The procedures to follow are set out in point 7 on the International Students' Office page

For citizens of non-EU countries who reside abroad and are applying for a student visa, and for students from China participating in the Marco Polo project who have chosen the Italian-language programme

In this case, a letter of pre-acceptance is not required, but you must **pass the Italian language proficiency test** (level B2), or submit a certificate of proficiency in Italian at a level no lower than B2, as indicated in point 1 on the International Students' Office page. This requirement applies only to those applying for enrolment on a degree programme taught in Italian

For students who are Italian citizens, citizens of EU countries (regardless of their country of residence) and citizens of non-EU countries holding a residence permit in Italy

Enrolment procedures
