1. Stages of the procedure

To be admitted to the programme, you must:

- a. **Pay** the fee of €10.00 in accordance with the procedures and deadlines set out in point 3.
- b. **Wait for the outcome** of the eligibility check. **If you do not meet the entry requirements**, you may acquire the missing credits by passing single examinations.
The procedures and costs are set out in the section 'Single Examinations' of the Regulations for Attendance at Bachelor's and Master's Degree Programmes and for Student Fees

- c. **Carry out the personal skills assessment** in accordance with the procedures set out in point 4.
- d. **Proceed with enrolment** by paying the course enrolment fees in accordance with the procedures and deadlines set out in point 5.
Enrolment can only take place once the Student Affairs Office has sent an email confirming the successful outcome of the eligibility and personal knowledge checks.

For students coming from other Italian universities

Students coming from other Italian universities must, after paying €10.00, submit a self-declaration stating the exams they have taken, the scientific-disciplinary sectors corresponding to the courses, and the relevant syllabuses, using the form "Dichiarazione laurea ed esami per verifica dei requisiti" available on the University website, on the student forms page

The submission can be made from the personal email address provided on Infostud at the time of registration, or from a certified email (PEC) address.

- If you are using your personal email account, the address to enter as the recipient is that of your Student Affairs Office or the address specified in the course requirements, available in the Degree Programmes catalogue on the page for each course, under the 'Enrolment' section. Before submitting your application, you must check that you have uploaded your identity document to Infostud, under 'Profile > Personal documents';
- If you are using a PEC email address, the address to enter as the recipient is protocollosapienza@cert.uniroma1.it

For students who have not yet obtained their degree

Where the course regulations so provide, students who have not yet obtained their degree (at Sapienza or at other universities) may also apply for verification of their eligibility, subject to the requirement to obtain it by 23 January 2027 (for students who have not yet obtained their degree at Sapienza) and by 19 December 2026 (for students who have not yet obtained their degree from other Italian or international universities).

For students from abroad and/or holding a qualification obtained within a foreign education system

The procedures for students from abroad are set out in point 6.

2. Admission requirements

To be admitted to the programme, applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or a three-year university diploma, or an equivalent qualification obtained abroad and recognised as suitable under current legislation.

Applicants must also meet specific academic requirements and demonstrate adequate personal knowledge.

To be eligible for admission to the Master's degree programme, you must meet one of the following two conditions:

I) hold a degree in class L-3 (Disciplines of the Visual Arts, Music, Performing Arts and Fashion) or in the corresponding class established pursuant to Ministerial Decree No. 509 of 3 November 1999;

II) have obtained at least 90 CFU in the following scientific disciplinary sectors (SSD):

- Historical SSDs: M-STO/01 (HIST-01/A) or M-STO/02 (HIST-02/A) or M-STO/03 (HIST-03/A), or M-STO/04 (HIST-03/B) or M-STO/06 (HIST-04/B) or SECS-P12 (STEC-01/B)
- Philosophical, Sociological and Anthropological Disciplines: M-DEA/01 (SDEA-01/A) or M-FIL/04 or M-FIL/05 (PHIL-03/A or PHIL-04/A) or SPS/07 or SPS/08 (GSPS-05/A or GSPS-06/A)
- SSD Design: ICAR/13 or ICAR/16 or ICAR/17 (CEAR-08/D or CEAR-09/C or CEAR-10/A)
- Arts and Performing Arts Specialisation: L-ART/01 or L-ART/02 or L-ART/03 or L-ART/04 or L-ART/05 or L-ART/06 (ARTE-01/A or ARTE-01/B or ARTE-01/C or PEMM-01/A or ARTE-01/D)
- SSD Economics: SECS-P/01 or /02 or /06 or /07 or /08 or /11 or /13 (ECON-01/A or ECON-02/A or ECON-04/A or ECON-06/A);
- SSD Computer Science: INF/01 (INFO-01/A)

Admission to the Master's degree programme is subject to passing an assessment of the applicant's academic knowledge, including a minimum B2 level of English, which will be conducted in accordance with the procedures set out in the programme's Academic Regulations.

3. Verification of eligibility

Eligibility checks must be requested by paying a €10.00 fee from 2 July 2026 and by one of the following dates, as chosen:

- 15 September 2026 (the only applicable date for applicants from non-EU countries requiring a student visa)

- 15 October 2026
- 17 November 2026
- 17 December 2026
- 14 January 2027 (date reserved for students who have already graduated from Sapienza or are about to graduate).

The payment is generated via the Infostud system.

The result of the eligibility check will be sent to your institutional email account (if active) or to the personal email address provided on Infostud.

4. Assessment of personal knowledge

The LM-65 degree class in Fashion Theory and Practice assesses whether applicants meet the entry requirements (including proficiency in English) via the website dedicated to managing the pre-selection procedures, from November of the year preceding the academic year of enrolment until the end of October of the academic year of enrolment.

The assessment is carried out by evaluating:

- the provision of an English language certificate issued by a recognised institution (IELTS, TOEFL, etc.);
- the consistency of the examinations taken during the Bachelor's degree (Laurea Triennale) as shown in the Transcript of Records or Diploma Supplement;

In some cases, it is possible to request a face-to-face interview (if already in Italy or for Italian citizens) or a telephone/online interview to assess skills and motivation.

If no English language certificate (B2) has been submitted, it is necessary to undergo a language proficiency test upon arrival in Italy.

5. Enrolment

Enrolment is granted upon payment of the course enrolment fees, following the successful completion of the assessment of entry requirements and personal knowledge.

The payment slip is generated via the Infostud system.

Payment is made online via PagoPA (direct payment).

Students enrolling on the Master's Degree Programme in Fashion Theory and Practices, run in collaboration with the University of Rome Unitelma Sapienza (an online university), will be required to pay, in addition to the regional tax, a tuition fee for the 2026–2027 academic year, **regardless of income, amounting to €1,600.00**. Enrolment is confirmed upon payment of the first instalment of the university enrolment fees for the 2026–2027 academic year, amounting to €800.00, to which the regional tax (if applicable) and stamp duty must be added.

A refund of these fees cannot be claimed following the award of the Laziodisco scholarship.

The amounts are set out in the Regulations for Attendance on Bachelor's and Master's Degree Programmes, Chapter IX – Amounts, ISEE, Tuition Fee Deadlines, under the heading "*standard tuition fee amounts*"

6. For students who hold a qualification from a foreign education system

The procedures vary depending on citizenship and country of residence.

For students of non-EU countries who reside abroad and are applying for a student visa, and for students from China participating in the Marco Polo programme

In these cases, you must hold a mandatory letter of pre-acceptance.
